1. INTRODUCTION OF COVENTRY UNIVERSITY

2. INTRODUCTION OF BSC ITB

BSc ITB originally offered at CityU since 2004.

The programme is the first non-local self-financed IT programme achieving local accreditation status in Hong Kong.

It aims to provide an integrative approach to the study of IT and business, emphasizing the application of IT for business success.

Students will be learning skills in programming, contemporary system development methodologies, business organisation and management.

 Accredited by HKCAAVQ at level 5 (Bachelor Degree) of the HK qualifications framework since 2010.

3. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- (1) possess an Associate Degree (AD) or a Higher Diploma (HD) in computing, business or equivalent; <u>AND</u>
- (2) have studied programming, information systems and systems analysis and design at AD/HD level or equivalent.

All students are required to possess pre-requite knowledge in application development, programming and database management.

Students who do not satisfy the admission requirement (2) but have relevant work experience may still be eligible for admission upon successful completion of a bridging module.

Programme Focus

- A specialist discipline that combines business management with information technology
- Consolidates knowledge of <u>IT students</u> and extend their expertise into business management
- Adapts knowledge of <u>business students</u> and expand their understanding of IT to explore the applicability of IT for business success
- Deals with contemporary issues in both IT applications and business management to bring students up-to-date with new developments

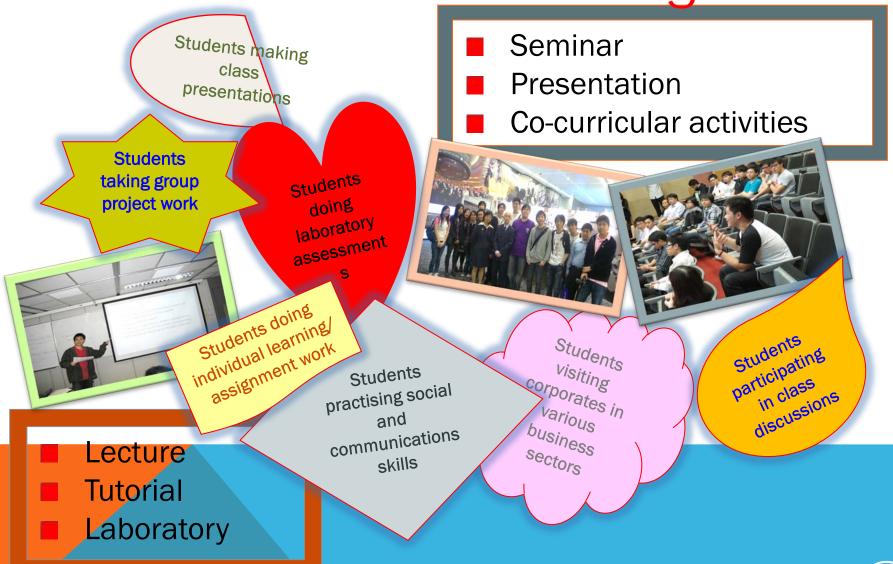
The SDU welcomes you to CityU SCOPE and wish you make the most of your study and campus life with us.
